Rules:

1. Entries must be set up between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on Friday, June 12, in the high school, room B-7.
2. Entries are open to everyone. Open judging at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12. Premiums will be paid after judging.
3. Artistic arrangements may contain material of designer's choice, including fresh cut, dried, or treated plant materials. Accessories are permitted; however, no artificial plant material is permitted.
4. Specimen flowers must be grown by the exhibitor.
5. An exhibitor may make any number of entries in each division of Class B, Roses, Class C or Perennials, providing each is a different named variety.
6. One entry may be made by each exhibitor in each division of Class A, Artistic Arrangements.
7. Entries must be removed by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 14.
8. Entries must be named to be judged.
