## ANGEL FOOD CAKE RECIPE

1 Cup sifted cake flour	1/4 teaspoon salt	3/4 cup sugar,
3/4 cup sugar,	1 1/2 teaspoons cream of tartar	1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla
	1 1/2 cups (12) egg whites	

Sift flour with 3/4 cup sugar 2 times; set aside. Beat egg whites with cream of tartar, salt, and vanilla until stiff enough to form soft peaks but still moist and glossy. Add remaining 3/4 cup sugar, 2 tablespoons at a time, continuing to beat until egg whites hold stiff peaks. Sift about 1/4 of the flour mixture over egg whites; fold in. Repeat, fold in remaining flour by fourths. Bake in ungreased 10 inch angel food cake pan at 375 for 35-40 minutes or until done. Invert cake in pan; cool. **Cake must be wrapped in clear plastic or 3 gallon clear plastic bag on a paper plate. Colored plastic wrap will not be accepted.**
